

Fused Fabric Card Sleeve Instructions

You Will Need:

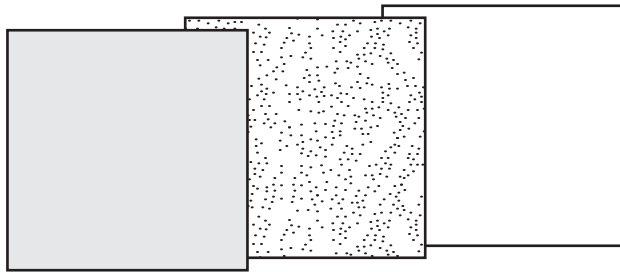
2 - 5" squares of fabric (one for the inside and one for the outside)

1 - 5" square of paper-backed fusible web

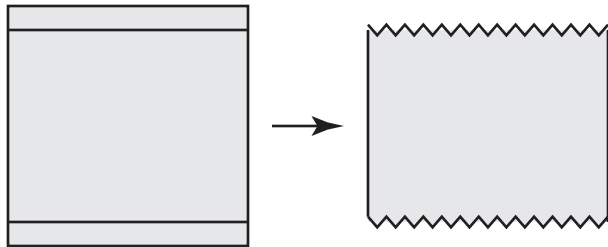
pinking shears, marking pencil

sewing machine

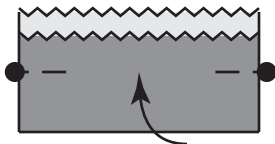
1. Fuse *wrong* side of fabric squares together using paper-backed fusible web.



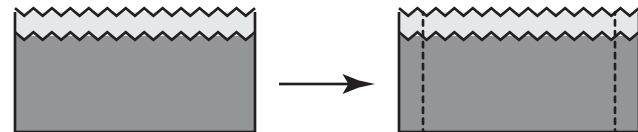
2. Lightly draw line $\frac{1}{2}$ " from opposite raw edges and trim on line with pinking shears.



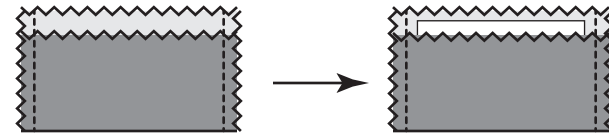
3. With *inside* fabric together, fold as shown and pin at side seams. We left approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ " of the inside fabric showing when we folded our sample.



4. Pin at side seams. The opening should be about $\frac{1}{4}$ " wider than the cards you will place in the sleeve. Mark seams to desired width and stitch on marked line.



5. Trim at side seams with pinking shears.
